The Financial Services Commission is an integrated regulatory body, established on April 1, 2011 by virtue of the Financial Services Commission Act (2010). It is charged with responsibility for supervising and regulating non-bank financial institutions in Barbados, particularly those entities in the insurance, credit union, securities and occupational pensions sectors.

LEGAL OFFICER

The Legal Officer performs an advisory role to the core functional regulatory streams (Credit Unions, Insurance, Securities and Pensions). The Legal Officer also provides in-house legal advice for Corporate and Board Secretarial services, and has responsibility for supervising the anti-money laundering and enforcement team.

The Legal Officer under the direction of the General Counsel is also responsible for representing the Commission before the Courts/Tribunal.
